



Granite Care & Maintenance Sheet

Your *FTL* Granite Countertop has been designed to be hassle-free. Follow our easy recommendations below to preserve the beauty of your original finish.

General Use

- Use hot-pads or trivets. Do not rest hot dishes directly on countertop. While more resistant to heat and scratching than other materials, Granite is NOT heat and scratch PROOF.
- Use cutting boards to avoid unnecessary scratching.

Everyday/Routine Cleaning

- Lightly scrub with a non-abrasive or spray cleaner that has a neutral PH and wipe clean with water and soft cloth. Acidic or Alkaline cleaners can affect the polish of your Granite countertops. Stonetech Revitalizer is a recommended everyday cleaner.
- Non-abrasive sponges are best, anything Teflon-safe is ideal.
- Avoid using dish soap, as these tend to leave behind a residue, which over time, builds up and traps grease, dirt, and stains.
- A polish such as, Stonetech Polish, may be used periodically to give an extra boost to your shine.

Everyday Stains

(Ink, Coffee, Curry, etc)

- A Neutral PH cleaner, such as Stonetech KlenzAll, maybe used to remove everyday stains.
- Scrub lightly and rinse completely with water and a soft cloth.

Tougher Stains & Scratches
